# FROM OUR EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

As we reflect on this year so far, **I'm deeply encouraged by all God is doing through this mission and through your continued support.**

In 2025, we've completed and scheduled 98 projects, served dozens of widows through our new widow care initiatives, and disbursed more than \$1 million to adoptive families and ministries. We're also on pace to complete 145 projects by the end of the year (more than any year in our history!)

We completed our first Both Hands project in 2007, meaning we're celebrating 18 years of impact. Only God could write a story like this one, where a simple idea to serve a widow and fund an adoption has now grown into a nationwide movement.

Together, we've seen:

- **1,700 children adopted** or in the adoption process
- **1,748 widows blessed** with a day of service
- **1,511 projects completed** across 45 states
- **\$22.5 million** raised for adoptions and orphan care

This wouldn't be possible without **YOU**. This report is a celebration of what we've accomplished together so far this year. As you read, I hope you're reminded that your generosity is making a lasting difference. Thank you for being a vital part of this ministry. We're thrilled to see what God will do next.

## Bexley is home!

Before they were even married, Luke and Robyn Spaulding knew adoption would one day be part of their story. That journey took an unexpected pause when Luke was diagnosed with cancer, a battle they faced with courage and faith.

Once Luke was in remission, God reignited the Spauldings' calling to adopt, and they stepped forward again, even when the cost felt daunting.

In May of this year, their Both Hands project brought together an army of friends and family to serve Ms. Shannon, a widow and mom of two, with home repairs. That day of service helped them raise **over \$26,000 for their adoption**, beating their initial fundraising goal!

And now... sweet Bexley is home! She has two new older brothers who will protect and defend her, two parents who love her to the moon and back, and a whole community in her corner for life. Praise God for the gift of Bexley!

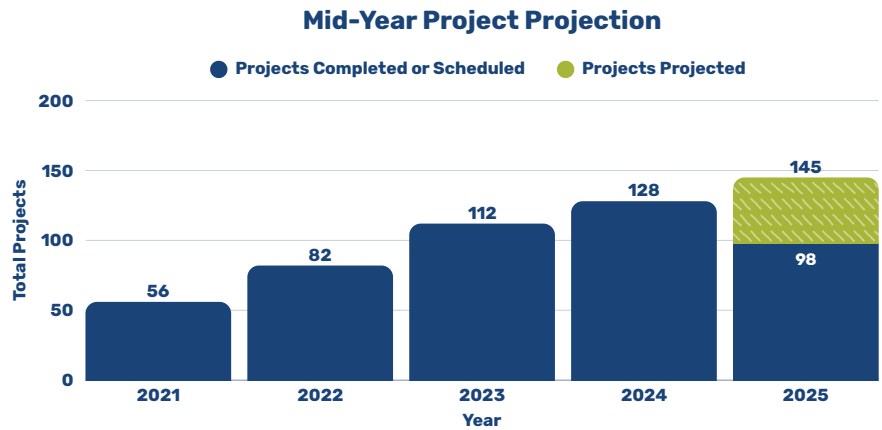
## Did you know?

## Projected Projects

We're over halfway through the year, and the momentum is undeniable. Based on our current pace and projections, **we're on track to complete 145 Both Hands projects** by the end of 2025, making this potentially our biggest year yet. Every project means more widows served and more families supported in their adoption journey.

## Widow Program

Since launching our Widow Care Program last year, we've connected with **64 widows** needing support beyond a typical project. With God's provision, we've expanded our impact through new initiatives like Brave Widow Memberships, which provide grief resources, online support groups, and one-on-one coaching to help widows heal in community.

## Partnerships

Another exciting milestone this year has been our **partnership with Foster the Family**, a nonprofit serving vulnerable children and families. With our coaching, they launched an orphan care project spanning eight sites, mobilizing volunteers to serve widows in their communities while **raising over \$116,000 to support their ministry**.

## Post-Adoption Projects

While adoption finalization is a major milestone, it's often just the beginning, especially when it comes to the medical, therapeutic, and emotional support many adopted children need to thrive. That's why we introduced Both Hands Post-Adoption Projects last year. It's a way for families to raise continued support for critical therapies and care while serving a widow.

Benji and Katie Davis Majors spent over 15 years living and serving in Uganda, where they adopted 13 daughters and later welcomed two sons into their family—a journey Katie shared in her best-selling book *Kisses from Katie*.

Now back in the U.S., the Majors family partnered with Both Hands for a post-adoption project, rallying friends and family to serve a woman who was widowed in their community, while **raising more than \$33,000**.

Every year, the Ty<sup>2</sup> Vision Project anchors our mission in action, and this year was no exception. This year, over 400 volunteers signed up to serve 20 widows through home repairs across Franklin and Brentwood, TN.

The Ty<sup>2</sup> Vision Project is unique in that it fuels our entire organization. While families never pay administrative fees on their adoption fundraising, this annual project raises critical operating support that makes that possible, ensuring that **100% of what families raise goes directly toward their adoption costs.**

Beyond the numbers, **the project honored the lives and legacies of Ty Osman, Sr. and Ty Osman II**, the project's namesakes, through hands-on service. Volunteers walked away inspired, widows felt seen and valued, and Both Hands was funded to serve more families and widows across the country.
